INDEX TO UNDERGROUND (second series)

The second series of UndergrounD commenced publication in 1975, simultaneously with the launch of Underground News as the Society's monthly periodical. Confusingly, Underground News continued the same series of issue numbers as the original series of UndergrounD but with no volume number, while the second series of UndergrounD continued volume numbers from the first series with a fresh series of issue numbers. Volume numbers were dropped after issue 3, and are ignored in this index. Dates were dropped from issue 9 and are likewise ignored in the index.

The second series was originally intended as a conventional magazine with each issue containing a variety of articles and photographs. However, from issue 8 onwards each issue covered a single topic and was in effect a stand-alone publication.
