# THE END OF LONDON UNDERGROUND TICKET OFFICES

Probably since 10 January 1863, ticket offices (booking offices, call them what you will) have been an integral part of Underground travel. All stations served by Underground trains at one time must have had a ticket office of sorts and only in recent years have the hours of operation at quieter stations been reduced and more recently still, ticket offices closed at such stations. Following this, some busier stations also lost their ticket office facilities. With some lift/escalator replacement schemes (e.g. Regent's Park and Charing Cross [Trafalgar Square]) and new stations (e.g. Wood Lane), ticket offices were not provided from day one.

Chigwell, Grange Hill, Roding Valley, Upminster Bridge and Theydon Bois booking offices closed some ten years ago from 5 February 2006, along with second offices at Bank (Northern Line), Baker Street (Chiltern Street), Liverpool Street (Broad Street entrance), Moorgate (Metropolitan Line), Southwark (west) and St. James's Park (Palmer Street). In addition, Vauxhall had closed when station upgrade work began. The 'exhibition' ticket office at Earl's Court was closed after the subway access was abandoned which was even before the present closures kicked off.

But it was only in early 2015 that a wholescale programme of closure began.

The following is a list of closure dates. Treat them with caution – because information about the closures was often difficult to acquire (a last day, a first day of no ticket office, or some locations closed earlier than planned to facilitate the closure!) – and therefore we will give just the month of closure. Certainly the last three LU ticket offices to close took place on Friday 18 December, at Upton Park, Aldgate East and – perhaps not surprisingly – St. James's Park! However, although no 'genuine' London Transport ticket offices now remain, there are a handful that were formerly staffed by Network Rail and are now part of London Underground. These are the stations on the DC lines (Queen's Park to Harrow & Wealdstone) along with Kew Gardens and Gunnersbury, all of which are (at the time of writing) still able to sell main line tickets as well.
