# **ROLLING STOCK CHANGES AND MOVEMENTS**

## 1972 TUBE STOCK:

Overhauled at Stonebridge Park Depot -

Five wheelchair bays fitted, on units: 3532, 3533, 3534, 3538, 3543. 3260+3532 are fitted with passenger information systems. Over half the fleet has had LED lighting fitted.

#### 2024 TUBE STOCK:

On 19 July 2023, the first complete train of 2024 Tube Stock was transferred to Wildenrath for extensive testing *(Below)* and current estimates put 4 July 2024 as the date for the first train of 2024 Tube Stock by rail from the PCW test track in Germany to Ruislip Depot.

In the numbering sequence, this is train 71, formed -

38071 - 39071 - 40071 - 41071 - 42071 - 45071 - 46071 - 47071 - 48071

Despite what it might initially look like from a distance, the double doors are not equally spaced, the spaces being 6.7m and 5.1m.

The series actually begins at '001' and it is assumed that this first train is a de-icer and others up to '094' will follow. Whether they will be in order (i.e. de-icers first and then the non de-icers, like the D Stock – or a mix of de-icers and non-de-icers, like the 1995/96 Tube Stocks) isn't yet clear.
